To the voters of Johnson County, TN you are hereby notified pursuant to TCA 2-12-111(a), that a State and Federal Republican Primary Election, Democratic Primary Election, and County General Election will be held in all voting precincts in Johnson County, TN, on Thursday, August 1, 2024, for the offices listed below.

State and Federal Primary Election and Independent Candidates

United States Senate	6 year term
United States House of Representatives (1 st Congressional District)	2 year term
Tennessee House of Representatives (3 rd Tennessee House of Representative District)	2 year term
Any other office or question that may appear on the ballot.	

County General Election

Sheriff (unexpired term)	2 year term
General Sessions/Juvenile Court Judge (unexpired term)	2 year term
Assessor of Property	4 year term
School Board Member (School Board District 2) two seats (Forge/Shouns, Trade, Neva & City)	4 year term
Any other office or question that may appear on the ballot.	

- The first day candidates for the August State and Federal Primary and Independent candidates for the November General Election may pick-up a nominating petition was February 5, 2024.
- The first day candidates for the August County General Election may pick-up a nominating petition was, February 5, 2024.
- Qualifying deadline will be **Thursday, April 4, 2024, at 12:00 NOON** for all candidates. TCA 2-5-101(a)
- **Candidates for Statewide Office** must file their original nominating petitions in the office of the State Election Commission, a certified duplicate petition in the office of the Coordinator of Elections and a certified duplicate petition with the chairperson of their party’s state executive committee by **Thursday, April 4, 2024, at 12:00 NOON**. TCA 2-5-101(a)
- **Other State Primary and Independent Candidates** must file their original nominating petition in the Election Commission Office of their county of residence and certified duplicate copies of their petition in each county wholly or partially within the candidate’s district by **Thursday, April 4, 2024, at NOON**. TCA 2-5-101(a)
- The Withdrawal Deadline will be **Thursday, April 11, 2024, at 12:00 NOON**. TCA 2-5-204 (b) (1)
- The last day to register to vote in person or by mail postmark for the August 1, 2024, Election will be **Tuesday, July 2, 2024**. TCA 2-2-109
- **No person shall qualify as a candidate for a position on a county board of education until the person has filed with the county election commission proof that the candidate graduated from high school or received a GED or HiSET evidenced by a diploma or other documentation satisfactory to the commission. The documentation must be filed no later than Thursday, April 4, 2024, at 12:00 Noon.**

Public Notice for Elderly Voters or Voters with Disabilities

Any elderly voter or voter with a disability whose polling place is inaccessible may vote early by absentee ballot or at the Election Commission Office on Election Day. TCA 2-3-109 (e) (1). If voters choose to vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day, they must complete an affidavit at the Election Commission Office **no later than July 22, 2024**, ten days prior to the election, stating that their designated voting location is inaccessible. For more information, please contact the Johnson County Election Commission office.

PHOTO ID REQUIRED FOR VOTERS: If you are voting in person during Early Voting or on Election Day, a Federal or State of Tennessee Government issued **photo ID** is required for voting, unless an exception applies. College student ID's and out-of-state photo ID's will not be accepted. Forms of acceptable identification, even if expired, include a Tennessee driver license with your photo, United States passport, Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security photo ID, Photo ID issued by the federal government, United States military ID including a Veteran Identification Card, and a Tennessee handgun carry permit with your photo.
